Magnolia Collection



Magnolia lilliflora 'Jane'- Reddish-purple flowers are white on the inside and appear before the foliage on this deciduous Magnolia. The foliage is dark green and glossy. Jane grows as a broad-rounded shrub.



Magnolia x 'Leonard Messel'- It has star-shaped flowers with 12 narrow petals while on the inside and purplish pink on the outside. The blossoms are fragrant and appear before the leaves in early to mid spring.



Magnolia soulangiana 'Rustica Rubra'-A deciduous tree with dark green leaves and goblet shaped flowers which are purple outside and white within.



Magnolia x 'Wadas Memory'- Small, fragrant white, blossoms appear before the foliage emerges in mid April. New leaves are tinged with red, elongated, green in summer and emit an anise scent when crushed.



Magnolia stellata 'Royal Star'- Medium, upright growing deciduous shrub or small flowering tree. Abundant white fragrant flowers with many more petals than other Magnolias.



Magnolia x 'Yellow Lantern'- Fragrant lemon yellow cup-shaped flowers with tan overtones held atop the branches in mid spring before the leaves. It has dark green foliage throughout the season. The large pointy leaves turn coppery bronze in fall.



Magnolia stellata 'Waterlily'- Bears slightly fragrant white flowers that blanket this compact tree in early to mid spring.



Magnolia virginiana- This tree is often grown as an ornamental landscape tree because of its attractive foliage, flowers and fruit. Large, multi-stemmed and evergreen this Magnolia is noted for its creamy white flower whose fragrance has been described as cool, sweet and fruity.



Magnolia x 'Butterflies'- It produces beautiful yellow star-shaped flowers during early to mid spring.. Sweetly scented. Foliage turns dark green by summer. Prune in late winter to keep shape.
