Blue Holly Collection



'Blue Girl'- The hardiest of hollies, displaying bright red berries through the winter. Use Blue Boy as a pollinator for a berry set.



'China Girl'- Producing the heaviest berry set of the hybrid Meserveae holly, China Girl also has far reaching appeal because of exhibited heat and drought tolerance, as well as hardiness.



'Blue Maid' -A true holly look in a dense, bushy plant with bright red berries and purple stems.



'Golden Girl'- The first yellow fruited variety, this densely branched evergreen shrub bears golden yellow on spiny blue green foliage.



'Blue Prince'- An upright evergreen holly with glossy, blue-green leaves. In late spring, this male cultivar bears inconspicuous white flowers which pollinate the female blue hollies.



'Red Beauty'- Compact evergreen holly that grows into a tight pyramid with little or no pruning. When pollinated by a male blue holly, this mini-tree is covered with pea-sized, bright red berries in fall and winter. Height 7-10'



'Blue Princess'- A true holly look in a dense, broad and shrubby plant, reaching 15' high by 10' wide. It has very abundant dark red berries, purple stems and extremely dark blue-green foliage.



'Honeymaid' - Blue-green leaves with a creamy white margin. The foliage is complimented by red berries in winter.



'China Boy'- An upright evergreen holly bearing glossy, spiny blue-green leaves. In late spring, it bears inconspicuous white flowers that pollinate the female blue hollies. China Boy tolerates heat and cold better than other Meserveae hybrids.



'Centennial Girl'- A naturally pyramidal, mite resistant Meserveae holly with deep green, foliage. The berry set on this holly is truly a spectacle well into early spring. Height 12-15'
