Buxus Collection



Buxus micro. 'Faulkner'-A compact shrub with oval glossy, bright green leaves that are densely packed. Leaves become bronzy tinged in winter. Slow growing dwarf means less shearing at maturity.



Buxus semp. 'Suffruticosa'- Slow growing compact shrub with a rounded habit. Small lustrous dark green leaves. Dense and compact. Great for edging and borders.



Buxus micro. 'Franklin Gem' - Broad, attractive small leaved evergreen shrub. Attractive bright green foliage becomes olive in winter. Hardest of all boxwoods.



Buxus semp. x 'Aureo-Variegata' - A slow growing shrub with a rounded habit. Leaves are green and yellow .



Buxus micro. 'Green Beauty' -A compact habit with dark glossy leaves. Popular evergreen shrub with rounded leaves and dense growth.



Buxus semp. x 'Elegantissima' -A striking boxwood that is most commonly used as an accent plant. It has small leaves that are splashed with cream coloring. Slow to moderate growth.



Buxus micro. 'Winter Gem' - - Dark green oval-shaped leaves with compact growth habit, 2-3' high with 2-3' spread, makes this variety excellent for a small hedge. The dark green foliage keeps its color through summer and winter.



Buxus semp. x 'Graham Blandy' Attractive columnar, upright form with dark green, rounded leaves and dense growth.



Buxus micro. 'Wintergreen' - A versatile, small and dense growing evergreen shrub with very refined dark green leaves that maintain color throughout winter. Excellent plant for formal hedges.



Buxus semp. x 'Green Gem'- A small lush mound of dark green summer foliage followed by some bronzing in winter. Naturally oval form and dense foliage is perfect for low hedges. Very small yellow flowers develop in small clusters in spring.

Buxus semp. x 'Green Ice' - Has glossy dark green evergreen foliage and is considered super hardy, maintaining a deep green winter color. The new spring growth is blue-green which turns a glossy, deep green in summer.



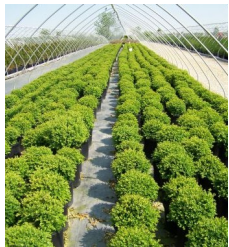
Buxus semp. x 'Tide Hill' - This rugged little boxwood has soft textured oval leaves that hold their bright green color through the winter. It has a broad spreading habit that is much less formal than that of the other boxwoods.



Buxus semp. x 'Green Mountain' - This upright dark green boxwood grows 5' high and 3' wide.



Buxus semp. x 'Varder Valley' - A distinctive blue foliage in the spring combined with excellent winter hardiness makes this mounding cultivar very appealing. More resistant to leaf miner than most boxwood cultivars.



Buxus semp. x 'Green Velvet' - One of the best selections for northern locations because it will hold its green color well into the winter.



Buxus semp. x 'Newport Blue' - A wide dwarf growing mound with stiff, upright branches growing 3-5" a year. Large, pointed oval-shaped blue-green foliage maintains year-round color.



Buxus semp. 'Rotundifolia' - A low-growing shrub with a rounded habit. Lustrous dark green leaves. Shears well. Compact and oval habit
