Fruit Collection



Malus 'Fuji'- Produces whitish-pink. The flowers in the spring, followed by medium super sweet, crisp apples.



Prunus 'Bing'- Extra large, heart shaped cherries with a deep maroon color.



Malus 'Honeycrisp'-A hardy, deciduous tree with a somewhat spreading habit. Honeycrisp is a large, very juicy, sweet apple with yellow skin overlain by red. It has little tartness and a mild apple flavor.



Prunus 'Fantasia'- Fruit is large with a glossy, red skin. Trees are vigorous, hardy and very productive.



Malus 'Royal Gala'-This tree produces apples with a mild and sweet flavor.



Prunus 'Red Haven'-In the spring this tree produces showy pink flowers and then juicy reddish peaches in mid summer.



Malus x 'Snowsweet'-A moderately vigorous tree with a somewhat droopy character. Pollinate with other mid and late season blooming apples.



Prunus 'Stanley' - A medium-sized tree with white flowers in spring. These give way to a generous early summer crop of large purple blue fruit with deliciously sweet, yellow flesh. They require regular moisture to ensure good fruit production and to prevent cracking of the skin.



Prunus maritima- Deciduous shrub with a dense rounded form, beach plum has dull green leaves that are pale green beneath. Single or double white flowers bloom in mid-spring, maturing to edible purple fruit. Extremely salt tolerant.



Ribes 'Nigrum'- Black currant is a medium shrub that grows 4 -5' tall with black fruit in the summer. Fruit is high in Vitamin C.

Rubus 'Anne Yellow'- A fall bearing golden raspberry . The large berries have a mild sweet flavor.



Vitis 'Himrod'- A yellow gold fruited variety with long loose clusters of medium sized berries that are great for fresh eating. One of the hardiest white seedless grapes, this variety ripens in late August.



Rubus 'Chester'-A medium sized bush with thorn less canes. White flowers in summer followed by dark blackberries in late summer.



Vitis 'Reliance'- A medium red seedless grape. It is great for fresh eating, or can be used for juice. Reliance requires annual pruning, adequate fertilization and maximum sunlight, ripening in early September.



Rubus 'Heritage'-This variety has medium sized red berries that have very good flavor and holding quality. Produces a crop in mid July and again in early September.



Vaccinium angustifolium- A low shrub, usually 6" to 2' tall and wide. Multiple stems, glossy foliage turns from red-green in spring to dark blue-green in summer to maroon-purple in fall. Small, white, bell-shaped flowers are followed by edible blue fruit.



Rubus 'Navaho'- The first erect growing thorn less blackberry which does not require a trellis. This hardy plant produces an abundance of large, deep blue to black fruit that ripens around the first of August and bears for one month.



Vaccinium 'Berkeley' - Bears large pale blue fruits in mid-summer. This is a popular choice for at home gardens. Small white flowers precede the fruits. The oval, glossy green leaves turn fiery colors in fall. Conspicuous yellow twigs provide winter



Vitis 'Concord'- The best known commercial variety, this vigorous trailing vine is grown for its large reddish-purple fruit in fall, excellent for eating fresh or in jellies.



Vaccinium 'Blue Crop'- One of the most drought resistant and frost tolerant high bush blueberry cultivars. Produces abundant sweet. Bright blue fruit in mid season. This shrubs foliage turns a fiery red in fall.

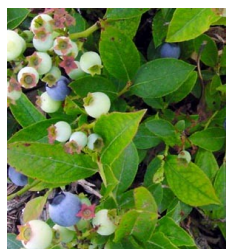
Vaccinium 'Blue Jay'- This variety will grow almost twice as fast as most other blueberries. 'Blue Jay' features ample crops of medium size, fruits. A large shrub, growing 6-7' with light green summer foliage, yellow-orange leaves in fall and bright yellow winter wood color.



Vaccinium 'Jersey'- Produces a large berry that are acidic when picked early but sweet when fully ripe in late June. This deciduous shrub is dense with an upright, multi-branch growth habit.



Vaccinium 'Blue Ray'- Produces large powder blue colored berries. They are soft, but firm and resist cracking. Pink blooms in the spring, glossy green foliage through the summer turning brilliant burgundy red in the fall.



Vaccinium 'North Blue'- A very hardy small shrub growing 2-3' tall. It produces dark blue berries with tart flavor. Heavy fruiting.



Vaccinium 'Chippewa'- This shrub is compact. The berries are very light blue with an excellent sweet flavor. Yields should average between 3 ½ to 7 pounds per bush at maturity.



Vaccinium 'North Country'- One of the earliest producing blueberry cultivars. It displays a profusion of white tinged pink flowers in spring. It is a vigorous growing cultivar reaching bearing age in 2 years and the fruit ripen in July.



Vaccinium 'Duke'- Bears fruit very early in the season. 'Duke' is one of the most acclaimed selection of northern high bush blueberry. Its small white flowers bloom later than those of most other varieties.



Vaccinium 'North Sky' - It is the most cold hardy of all the blueberries and will be the most productive with winter snow cover. It grows in a compact mound and begins spring covered in snow white blooms.



Vaccinium 'Elliot'- A late season cultivar that will extend your harvest. In spring, mature plants are covered in small white flowers followed by excellent fall color and reddish winter branches.



Vaccinium 'Patriot'- Prized not only for its early crop of large sweet blueberries but also its profusion of pink-tinged white flowers. Multi-stemmed shrub has lovely yellow bronze and red fall color.

Vaccinium 'Pink Lemonade'- In spring, the shrub sports pink/white flowers. The fruits appear green then dappled pink and finally develop a deep pink. The leaves are green with serrated leaf margins. In fall, the leaves turn a bright orange fading to deep red. In Winter twigs are dusky reddish-brown.



Vaccinium 'Reka'- Heaviest bearing variety. Early –mid season ripening, fruit is mid-sized.
