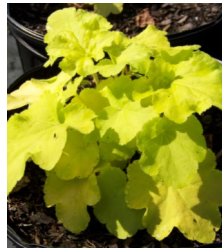


JOHNSON FARMS

Heuchera Collection



'Beaujouis'-A large grower with burgundy leaves and a touch of silver and deeper veins. A very vigorous grower. Heat, humidity and salt tolerant.



'Citronelle'- The large lobed leaves are a striking lime-yellow color that will definitely draw attention in the garden.



'Beauty of Color'- A perennial with an attractive mound of green and burgundy marbled with silver foliage and tall, arching stems of tiny, bell shaped white flowers in spring to summer.



'Dark Secret' - The leaves are heavily ruffled in a deep purple-bronze with a slight silver sheen. Sprays of cream flowers appear in early to mid summer .



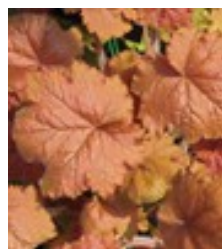
'Blackout'- Forms a low mound of large and gently lobed leaves of deep charcoal black with a smooth and shiny surface. Taller sprays of ivory white flowers appear in early summer.



'Encore' -Starts out in the spring with deep rose-purple colored leaves that have a light silvery on top, darker veins and vibrant reddish-purple undersides.



'Brownies'- Brownies produces a large dome-shaped mound of huge chocolate-green leaves with purple-red underside. It's a great plant for setting off lighter colored perennials in the landscape.



'Kassandra' -A vigorous grower that shows a lot of very interesting leaf changes throughout the season . In the spring, it emerges caramel to orange, and is maroon to a reddish-pink by the end of the season.



'Caramel' - This coral bells selection has scalloped leaves that emerge gold in spring, deepening to amber and peach. Sprays of light pink flowers appear in midsummer.



'Melting Fire'- The mature foliage is deep maroon with heavily ruffled edges. Dark red stems carry a profusion of white flowers in late spring and early summer.

'Miracle'-Goes through several changes in leaf coloration throughout season. Starts out chartreuse with heavy smattering of reddish-purple in the center. As it matures turns brick red with bright chartreuse. to gold edge and silvered underside.



'Mocha'- Compact with nicely arranged rich purple foliage that is deepened in summer sun.



'Palace Purple'-Attractive deep purple above and beet red beneath. Foliage color may fade to a bronze green in hot summer. Tiny, pinkish-white, bell-shaped flowers bloom in late spring to early summer.



'Pinot Gris'- Ginger leaves with silvery overlay age to smoky rose with a rosy purple underside.



'Pistache' - A robust grower with large, light lime green to chartreuse-yellow leaves depending on the sun exposure.



'Plum Pudding'- Plum Pudding has purple foliage with leaves that are marbled with silvery highlights. If you keep the soil from drying out, then the foliage will shimmer through the cold.



'Silver Scrolls' - The silvery, lobed leaves of 'Silver Scrolls' are decorated with deep burgundy-green veining and contrasting, purple undersides. A subtle display of delicate, whitish, bell-shaped flowers appear.



'Snow Angel' -Mounds of low growing light green, broadly lobed leaves are marbled with a light cream variegation and flower spikes of pinkish- red bells.



'Tiramisu' - Compact habit, spring and fall foliage is chartreuse with a heavy smattering of brick red. During summer the leaves lighten to chartreuse and develop a light silver overlay.
