## Hydrangea Collection



**Hydrangea arb. 'Annabelle'**- Annabelle a showy, vigorous, native shrub bears dramatic creamy-white, rounded flower heads that may reach up to a foot across.



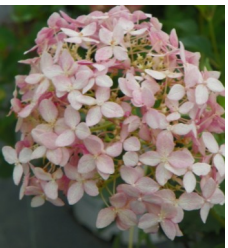
**Hydrangea macro. 'Forever Pink'**- Giant 6-8" flower heads will cover this shrub in mid to late summer. Flower clusters hold their lovely pastel-pink color quite well, and add interest to cut and dried flower arrangements.



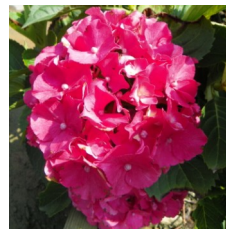
**Hydrangea arb. 'Incrediball'** - Massive flowers bloom in summer, and are held up by very sturdy stems.



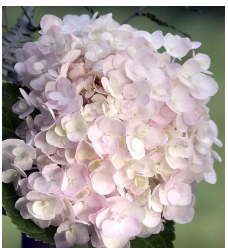
**Hydrangea macro. 'Light o Day'**- Lace cap type flowers of blue or pink depending on the soil acidity. A large mound of wonderfully variegated leaves of white and green showcase the blooms.



**Hydrangea arb. 'Invincibelle Spirit'**-This breeding breakthrough has giant 12" flowers of bright pink that will color your garden from early summer to fall frost!



**Hydrangea macro. 'Masja'**- A good choice for smaller gardens, the tidy plant offers up armfuls of ball-shaped, pink-toned blooms against dark green, glossy leaves.



**Hydrangea macro. 'Blushing Bride'**- Pure white blooms with semi-double florets gradually mature to a sweet pink blush.



**Hydrangea macro. 'Nikko Blue'**- The 'Nikko Blue' has large, round flower heads that are a bold blue. The flowers bloom in late spring, over a rounded canopy of dense foliage.



**Hydrangea macro. 'Endless Summer'**-Endless Summer will begin to bloom in spring and repeat through fall. Easy to grow with very little care. Blooms will be pink in acid type soils and blue in alkaline soils.



**Hydrangea macro. 'Penny Mac'**- This compact selection produces many mop-head-type blooms of pink or medium blue. It is a medium-sized, deciduous shrub with attractive deep green leaves that turn shades of burgundy in fall.

**Hydrangea macro. 'Pia'**- Pia is a dwarf mophead with a globe-shaped flower heads made up of deep rose, 4" wide flowers.



**Hydrangea macro. 'Grandiflora'**- Large, sometimes giant white flowerheads reaching 6-18" long and turning pink with age. 'Grandiflora' is a fast growing shrub that can reach 25' tall.



**Hydrangea macro. 'Twist & Shout'** - Twist-n-Shout produces abundant blooms on both old and new wood all summer long. Lacy, deep-pink centers are surrounded by gorgeous blossoms of pink or periwinkle blue, depending on soil type.



**Hydrangea panic. 'Limelight'**- Unique bright green blooms in mid-summer holds its bright and refreshing color right into autumn when the blooms change color to a rich deep pink.



**Hydrangea macro. 'Variegata'**- A variegated shrub with bright green foliage surrounded by white margins. Hydrangea 'Variegata's' rounded clusters of pinkish-white summer flowers hold their own with the striking foliage .



**Hydrangea panic. 'Pink Diamond'** - It blooms in July and August with large medium-pink flowers. Blooms on new growth.



**Hydrangea macro. 'Glowing Embers'**-A showy mop head hydrangea with crimson-pink flowers in large, rounded heads and broad, coarsely toothed, glossy, dark green leaves. The blooms last from June to August and then dry beautifully.



**Hydrangea panic. 'Bombshell'**- Covered in white flowers against medium green to dark green foliage from early summer until frost, this cultivar has more flowers per plant than any other Hydrangea paniculata.



**Hydrangea macro. 'All Summer Beauty'**- All Summer Beauty' is compact and prolific and offers big, round clusters of pastel blue or pink flowers from mid-summer through fall.



**Hydrangea panic. 'Chantilly Lace'**- Large green leaves line the stems in spring and darken with age. In mid to late summer the large panicles of huge, pyramidal flower clusters appear.

**Hydrangea panic. 'Phantom'** - Fullest flower heads of the panicle hydrangeas. This hydrangea features bold conical white flowers with pink overtones at the ends of the branches from mid summer to late fall.



**Hydrangea quercifolia**- Multiple stems are sparingly branched with picturesque canes. Older stems are exfoliating to reveal a rich, brown inner bark. The showy inflorescence of greenish flowers, turn white then purplish.



**Hydrangea panic. 'Pinky Winky'** - Strong, upright red stems hold the massive, two-toned, white and pink flowers in mid-July.



**Hydrangea quercifolia 'Pee Wee'**- A nice dwarf and compact form of Oakleaf Hydrangea with white flowers blooming in early summer. The flowers fade to light pink and the leathery leaves turn a superb burgundy autumn color.



**Hydrangea panic. 'Quickfire'** -It blooms months earlier than other varieties. Loosely-held blooms open creamy white then quickly turn a deep rosy-pink.



**Hydrangea quercifolia 'Sikes Dwarf'** - A dwarf selection with handsome, closely spaced foliage and numerous white flower heads. Great for smaller gardens.



**Hydrangea panic. 'Sweet Summer'**- Green flowers mature to white in Summer and turn shades of pink in Fall



**Hydrangea petiolaris**- This clinging vine has distinctly red-brown branches covered with lustrous, dark green leaves. In late spring to summer it produces clusters of white lacecap flowers. In the winter, it's pretty peeling red-brown bark provides interest.
