## Winterberry Holly Collection



**'Berry Heavy'** - This holly will produce large amounts of bright red berries enjoyable from late fall through Christmas. The lustrous deep green foliage is cast with plum-bronze in the fall. Pollinate with a male 'Jim Dandy' .



**'Sparkleberry'** - This popular cultivar 'Sparkleberry' is renowned for its heavy loads of bright red berries that brighten the fall and winter landscape. In mid-spring, its new foliage emerges with burgundy-purple hues and quickly changes to glossy medium green.



**'Red Sprite'** - From fall to mid-winter, the dwarf winterberry 'Red Sprite' offers abundant bright red berries that line otherwise bare branches.



**'Winter Red'** - more shade tolerant than most varieties, the extremely dark green foliage and abundant amount of large, bright red fruit will persist into late winter until birds find them.



**'Southern Gentleman'** - Extremely hardy holly with rich deep green foliage on oval-rounded form. Plant as a pollinizer for female winterberry plants. Produces no berries.



**'Jim Dandy'** - Jim Dandy is a male winterberry that is used to pollinate a female winterberry. You'll see lots of very small flowers on this shrub, but no fruit.



**'Apollo'** - A great pollinator for the 'Winterberry' . New growth appears red.
